

Ready to become an Aggie?

LEARNING to Transfer?



Students who are ready to transfer to the NMSU Las Cruces and Global Campuses from an internal community college must submit a change of campus form. The form is routed to Undergraduate Admissions and Orientation for processing. If the student meets requirements, the request is processed and the student is notified of their next steps. These students are then tracked to see if they enroll in courses at NMSU. It was observed that a small population of students go back to the community colleges to enroll indicating they were not ready to transfer.

Objective: This assessment was done to determine if the introduction of the Aggie Pathway Advisor has made an impact on students learning when they will need to transfer to NMSU.

<u>Methodology</u>: Using our Change of Campus data and enrollment information, the data points on the chart were gathered to determine if there were any trends and/or changes in the number of students who actually transfer during the semester they indicated. This would demonstrate students' learning about the transfer process and getting assistance before submitting the form.
